It's up to you to decide how your bequest will be used, however a general gift allows us to direct the monies received to the areas of greatest need.

CLAUSE FOR YOUR WILL:

To set up a legacy gift simply ask your lawyer to add the following statement to your will:

"I give to the Aeolian Hall Musical Arts Association, 795 Dundas Street, London, Ontario N5W 2Z6, charitable registration number 866178916 RR0001, the sum of \$ _____, or _____% of the residue of my estate or my property at _____ in the City of _____ . The disposition of my bequest is to be used by the Aeolian Hall Musical Arts Association at its discretion."

IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A WILL:

You need not re-write the entire document to include a bequest to the Aeolian Hall Musical Arts Association. Instead, a simple clause known as a codicil can be used to amend your Will. Below, you'll find examples of codicil language that you may wish to make use of. Of course, we strongly recommend that you consult with your lawyer or estate planner when considering making a bequest.

Percentage of Estate Gift

"I give to the Aeolian Hall Musical Arts Association _____ per cent of the value of my estate to be used for its general purposes."

Residual Gift

"I give to the Aeolian Hall Musical Arts Association one hundred per cent (100%) of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate for its general purposes."

Fixed Amount Gift

"I give to the Aeolian Hall Musical Arts Association the sum of \$_____ to be used for its general purposes."
